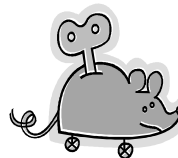
Marching into Africa

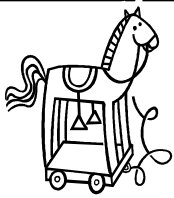
