

Brookfield State School Tuckshop menu Term 1 2009

Tuckshop days: Monday, Wednesday and Thursday

(In the event of a public holiday or pupil free day, no extra tuckshop day will be scheduled)

All grades are now having their long break at 11am. Bag orders are now for first break only.

How to order tuckshop:

1. Please mark clearly on each bag the child's name, class, details of the order and money enclosed.
2. Please use a separate paper bag for each food item required.
3. Drinks for Prep to year 3 will need a separate bag and will be sent out with the food order. Years 4-7 will have their bags stamped and students can return their bags to the tuckshop to collect their drinks.
4. Gluten free and Lactose free items need to be ordered in a white paper bag.
5. Please do not sticky tape or staple bags. Where possible please use the correct money (Australian currency only!) Change will be returned with the bag.
6. Bolognese pasta and iceblocks cannot be delivered to the classroom. Children will need to return to the tuckshop to collect these items.
7. For parents of children with food allergies, we cannot guarantee our tuckshop is free from these items and you use this service at your own risk. Please feel free to contact our convenor or the school office if you have any queries.

What to write on your bag:

1. Child's Name
2. Class
3. Details of order, using a separate paper bag for each food item.
4. Cost of the order and how much money is enclosed.
5. Any change required.
